The undersigned desiring electric service (hereinafter called Applicant) hereby applies for the service and membership at the premises and location described below, and agrees to purchase from THE CANEY VALLEY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATION, INC., (hereinafter called Cooperative) all central station electric energy requirements when it is made available to him. The applicant agrees to provide any easements or right-of-way necessary at no cost to the Cooperative for the Cooperative to provide service to them. The class of service being applied for is as follows: ( ) Farm/Home ( ) General Service ( ) Industrial ( ) Etc.

The Customer will pay the Cooperative the sum of \$5.00 which, if properly acceptable by the Cooperative, will constitute the membership fee and payment for one share of capital stock of the Cooperative. Such stockholders are not liable under law for the attachments of their properties for debt and liabilities of the Cooperative.

The Applicant will cause his premises to be wired in accordance with wiring specifications approved by the Cooperative and in conformance with the National Electric Code.

The term AConsumer@ shall be understood to refer to those served by the Cooperative, whether they are members or non-members.

The rates, charges, terms and conditions as on file with this Cooperative will apply. Payment for service rendered and the minimum bill will be in accordance with the applicable rate schedule.

SECURITY DEPOSIT - The Cooperative may require the Customer to provide credit information prior to rendering electric service. The Cooperative may also require at any time, upon proper notice, a cash security deposit in accordance with the Cooperative's Rules and Regulations. Such deposit will bear interest and be refunded in accordance with those Rules & Regulations.

The agreement for service under this application shall commence on the date that service was made available by the Cooperative, and continue thereafter until canceled by written or oral notice given by the customer to the cooperative or by disconnection of the Customer's service by the Cooperative.

DELIVERY OF SERVICE - Service to be furnished under this agreement is to be delivered and received at a mutually agreed upon point on the Customer's premises as listed below. The Cooperative's meter shall constitute the point of delivery to the customer, unless determined otherwise by the Cooperative, and the Customer will own and maintain all poles, wires, equipment and other facilities beyond the point of delivery. The amount of power and energy to be supplied to an industrial consumer may be limited to the Cooperative's existing facilities and therefore reasonable restrictions may be placed on the supplying of the service. The Cooperative cannot guarantee 100% continuity of service.

ACCESS - the Cooperative will have the right of access to the Customer's premises for the purpose of installing, reading, inspection, or repairing any meters, devices and other equipment or for any purpose incidental to the electric service supplied by the Cooperative.

COMPLIANCE - Failure on the part of the customer to accept service from the Cooperative, to comply with the Certificate of Incorporation, Bylaws, Rules & Regulations, or to carry out the terms and conditions of this contract, shall not relieve the Customer from the payments and conditions set forth in this contract. The Customer hereby gives written consent to the Cooperative to transfer to the Customer's current service account, regardless of class, any unpaid balance owed for service received or costs incurred at this or any separate metering point, residence or location, regardless of the class of service received or when such service was received whether prior, concurrent or successive.

When this instrument is executed by the Applicant and the Cooperative, it shall constitute the agreement covering the service.
